

Applying for Health Insurance on HealthCare.gov?

Have this information on hand to help complete the application

Have this information for everyone in your household:

- Full names (as they appear on government documents)
- Dates of birth
- Social Security numbers and/or immigration documents (only for people in your family who are applying for coverage)
- Amount of income everyone received this month
- Estimate of everyone's income for 2021 (go to bit.ly/btbincome for a worksheet that will help you estimate your income)
- Your most recent tax return, if you have it
- Name & phone number of company where each person works

Important

- Does your job (or your spouse's job) offer health insurance?

If yes, you'll need information about how much the job's insurance costs for just the employee (not for the whole family).

To speed up the application process, try to have these ready when you apply:

- If you have an account on HealthCare.gov, have your username and password
- Your email address and the password for your email account

To make it easier to choose a health plan, bring this information:

- Names of doctors each person visits
- Names of medicines each person takes
- Name of your family's preferred hospital

Don't worry if you don't have some of this information!
You can still complete an application on HealthCare.gov without it.
